5. No stallions allowed on grounds except weanlings.
6. SEI approved helmets are required for all English & gymkhana event & must fit properly.
7. All riders must dismount & lead their horse from the ring in all gymkhana classes.

8. Club Display, for Presque Isle County Only, will be judged as a group, on how well you work together, cleanliness of tack, & oral questions from the judge. You may lead your horse in saddled,

with a halter, & with bridles over the horn.
